

GUIDELINES FOR LEVERHULME TRUST DISCRETIONARY BURSARY

Hothouse is subsidised by a grant from the Leverhulme Trust. The fee for Hothouse 2024 is £50.

There is a small discretionary bursary fund which Hothouse dancers can apply for towards fee.

Grants for fees will be decided depending on total household income.

For example, you can apply for a grant of up to £50 if your total household income (before tax) is £25,000 or under, if you are in care or if you are in receipt of one of the following – Universal Credit; Young Carer Grant; Income Support; Income-based Job Seeker’s Allowance or Employment and Support Allowance; Refugee or Asylum seeker

Please note – funding awards are made at the discretion of the YDance staff and are not guaranteed.
